**The Executive Committee of the Iraqi Inter-Religious Council for Peace (Iq-IRC) met for the first time in Baghdad, following its successful inaugural meeting, held in Amman, Jordan, on 28 May 2003, under the auspices of HRH Prince El-Hassan bin Talal.**

**The Committee expressed its determination to establish a permanent presence in Baghdad to oversee the application of its principles and goals, and expressed its full commitment to cooperate with representatives of all religions and religious leaders of the Iraqi people.**

**The Committee decided to establish a sub-committee to mobilize its efforts with the view to coordinating the provision of humanitarian assistance to the Iraqi people.**

**The Committee recalled its Joint Statement, issued following the meeting of May 2003, with regard to the responsibility of the Provisional Coalition Authority in establishing peace and security throughout Iraq.**

**The Committee called upon the Iraqi Transitional Governing Council to exert maximum efforts in providing the Iraqi people free, honorable and stable living conditions.**

**The Committee expressed its commitment to serve as a consultative body to international organizations and to institutions of the Iraqi Government.**

**As the Council represents the religious leadership of the Iraqi people, it pledges to remain united in serving their interests and aspirations.**

**The Committee expresses its gratitude and appreciation to all religious leaders who participated in its meetings.**
